To achieve the desired reflective surface, intensive polishing sessions are required. Even today, these master craftsmen use indigenous methods and materials to produce these exquisite metal-alloy mirrors. Needless to say, It takes tremendous practice, concentration and patience to produce a fine mirror.
